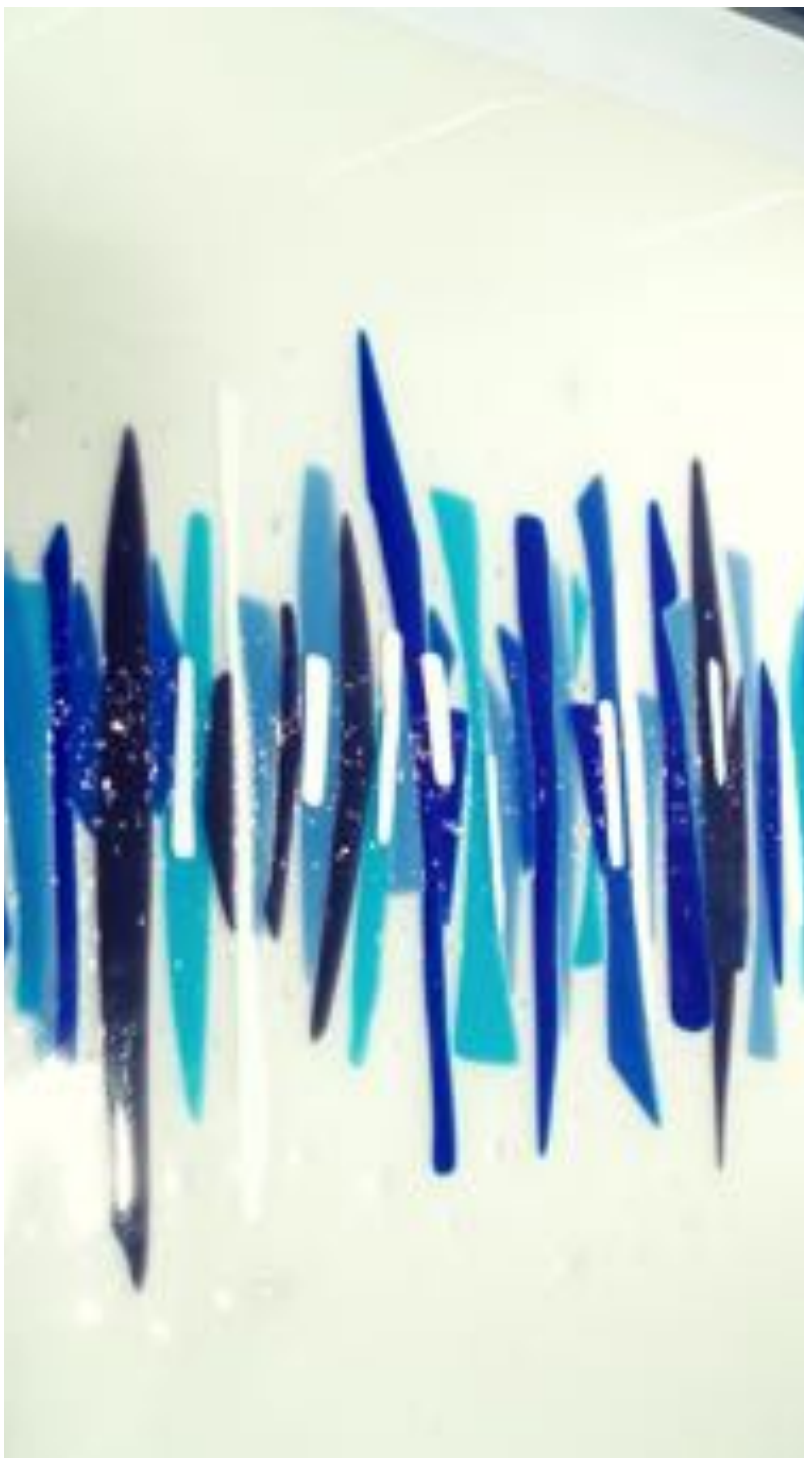

ABOUT US

Glassification has been owned and run by glass artist Liz Sparkes from her large workshop in Ilminster, Somerset since 2011.

As a kitchen designer with more than 30 years experience, when Liz discovered her love of kiln formed glass, it was a natural progression to use the art form in the room she understood the best, the heart of every home, the kitchen.

Liz not only designs and makes splashbacks but continues to develop as an artist in her chosen medium, glass, which means her panel designs are also evolving and developing. For our customers this means that their own panel will always be unique.



WHAT IS KILN FORMED GLASS?

Sometimes known as warm glass, or fused glass, kiln formed glass is an art form using pre-made sheets of coloured glass, cutting and arranging them into designs, and then heating them in a very precise controlled way in flat bed kilns.

The resulting art can then be mounted and wall hung, or returned to the kiln on a lower heat, to form new shapes, such as bowls, vases, and lampshades, as well as free standing sculptural pieces.

OUR SERVICES



DESIGN

All our panels go through a design process. Together with our customers we make sure that the panel is right for them and their home, even when a design is chosen from an earlier design, each panel is treated as a newly commissioned piece, ensuring it is perfect for its place, and is completely unique.



MAKE

Once the design is agreed, Liz and her team order the art glass and other materials required and then start cutting and assembling the panel. Once placed in the kiln, the heating and careful cooling process can take up to 3 days.



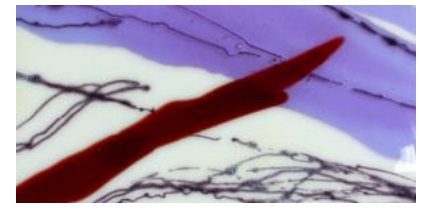
INSTALL

CONTEMPORARY DESIGNS

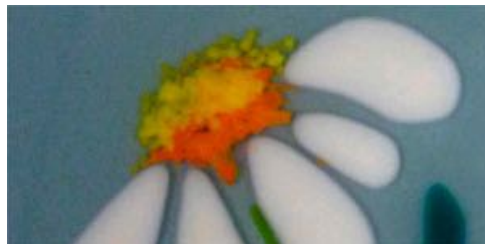
Kiln formed glass lends itself to contemporary designs, with it's strong shapes and colours.

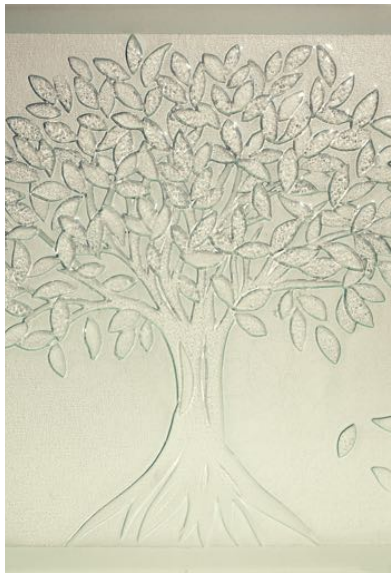




FLORAL DESIGNS

EMBOSSSED GLASS DESIGNS

By creating a design in special refractory paper on the floor of the kiln, a unique embossed design can be created in transparent glass, leaving the surface smooth and easy to clean.

Many variations on this style are possible, from geometric to floral designs. The use of lettering is also very effective.

As one of our most popular styles it lends itself to timeless elegance and is available in over 15 subtle colours



COMMISSIONING A PANEL

We make the process of commissioning a unique panel for your home simple. Even if you have never worked with an artisan before, or have no idea (now!) of what you want, we will guide you through the process.

Through informal discussion, and creating mood boards as well as looking at our past work we will carefully work together until you are happy with the design. We will also make small sample pieces for you along the way just to make sure we are both on the right track, so when your panel is installed you will be totally delighted!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

01. Are your panels toughened? Not toughened, but "tougher". Toughed glass is window glass which has gone through a specific process, we use coloured art glass. However it has also gone through an annealing process making it much much stronger, strong enough to withstand being behind a hob,

02. Do you guaranteed your panels? Yes, they are guaranteed for 5 years against manufacturing issues.

03. Can you cut out around sockets? Yes we can, however we choose not to. Cutting holes in glass stresses it, and in time the glass will crack. Speak to your kitchen designer about all the ways you can hide sockets in kitchens and let your panel shine forever!

04. Can we take the panel with us if we move? Your panel will be part of your kitchen. It will be designed for that space and stuck firmly to the wall, (just like a large tile) so moving it isn't an option... but how about commissioning us for a replacement when you move, or for a wall panel which could be mounted in any other part of your home and moved with you?

05. Can we visit your workshop? You are very welcome to visit us, but please give us a call first to make sure we are there, and not out installing a splashback somewhere!
